BLACK FAITH LEADERS


By supporting Black faith leaders across the state, we promote social justice and racial equity within religious communities. We actively listen to and uplift Black faith leaders, provide resources and opportunities for leadership development, and create a supportive and inclusive environment for them to advocate on behalf of the people they serve.



BLACK FAMILIES IN TRENTON, NJ

We provide wraparound services for Black families including mental health support, mentoring, housing support, job readiness and employment opportunities, entrepreneurial empowerment training, and more.

We collaborate with Trenton residents to empower and support them in identifying, designing, and implementing community-led solutions that directly address the challenges and systemic disparities faced by Black communities.



THEORY OF CHANGE

SandSJ's theory of change seeks to journey with the most impacted by structural racism from lament to liberation. We do this by using our vast statewide Black faith network to identify impacted persons in communities, use visioning sessions to reimagine alternatives to existing structures and then support them to advocate for the change they seek.

The power, history, and narrative of Black faith to imagine beloved communities and push towards freedom is at the center of this work. We work to engage impacted people in Black communities to imagine prison and policing alternatives, abolish the drug war and invest in health solutions, dismantle segregation in education, and promote civic engagement. SandSJ works with impacted people to realize their power and train them to advocate for their own liberation.



RJVIA IMPACT IN NUMBERS

1/23/2023 - 6/29/2025

367 Incidents answered by Trenton Restorative Street Team (TRST)

253 Trenton residents connected to services (12 in 2025; 71 in 2024; 108 in 2023)

Types of services connected to (of the 253):
• 96 Mental Health

- 43 Food Distribution referrals
- 11 Housing
- 25 workforce development
- 15 education support
- 56 wrap-around services
- 1 legal service

RJVIA IMPACT IN NUMBERS

SandSJ was involved in 158 Partner Business Referrals

- **16** in 2025
- **28** in 2024
- **64** in 2023
- 103 of the 158 referrals were from NJLEAD Program
- 37 of 158 referrals were from the Youth Life Skills Program

159 Internal SandSJ Referrals

- **88** in 2025
- **71** in 2024
- **0** in 2023 (process flow did not allow for internal referrals); and zero blank records captured.

Outreach Events data points are from 12/9/22 to 6/29/25

- 132 outreach events with 1,273 individual persons reported to have participated in the events.
- 31 event reports so far in 2025 with 67 reported participants.
- 44 events captured in 2024 with 929 reported participants
- 57 (52 and 5 events in 2023 and 2022 respectively) with a combined 277 reported participants.



FEBRUARY 2021

CANNABIS BILL

Cannabis legalized with a social equity excise tax and 70% of sales tax to be invested back to communities most impacted by prohibition. Which funds our community-based violence intervention efforts



AUGUST 2022

RESTORATIVE JUSTICE BILL

Salvation and Social Justice -- along with the New Jersey Institute for Social Justice -- played a pivotal role in community organizing and advocating Restorative Justice legislation in New Jersey. On August 11, 2021, Lieutenant Governor Sheila Oliver signed into law the "Restorative and Transformative Justice for Youths and Communities" pilot program, which will operate in Camden, Newark, Paterson, and Trenton. \$8.4 million will move from youth incarceration to a community-led solution.




JANUARY 2024

SEABROOKS-WASHINGTON BILL

Governor Murphy signed S4250/A5326, the "Seabrook-Washington Community-Led Response Act," to establish community-led first response team pilot programs throughout the state.

The crisis response teams are an alternative to police responses for mental/behavioral health, substance use, and nonviolent calls. and nonviolent calls and appropriates \$12M to the community.



BLACKFAITH IMPACT

- Launched Souls to the Polls, a faith-based movement to engage the community and involve them in the political process
- Launched The Black Faith Collaborative, a "one-stop shop" for Black faith leaders to access training, information, resources, and opportunities for engagement with ongoing policy work.
- Contributed to a 13% increase in est. Black voter turnout in predominantly Black cities in NJ (2017 vs 2025)



LEGISLATIVE IMPACT

- Racial Impact Bill
- Solitary Confinement Restriction Law
- Independent Prosecutor Law
- The COVID-19 Credits Bill was signed to law, which led to 9000 adults and youth being released from prison during the pandemic
- Restorative Justice Hub Bill signed into law



COMMUNITY IMPACT

- Launch of Restorative Justice Hub
- Launch of Trenton Restorative Street Team
- Mobile Customer Relationship Management (CRM) application created with Microsoft for the Street Team
- 40% reduction in homicides in Trenton.



ADVOCACY IMPACT

- Youth Prison Closure Announcement
- Restored Voting Rights to 83,000 formerly incarcerated
- Advocated and was awarded \$2M for Black Church Led Birthing Center in Trenton.


