## **RETURN & RESTORE**

**Policy Advocacy Checklist: Second Look** 

The purpose of this checklist is to outline all the necessary tasks to consider in hosting a "Policy Saturday/Sunday" event in your faith community and advocate beyond. You can share this document with other faith networks across the state as a template to encourage preaching, teaching, and mobilizing to advocate for the rehabilitative release of certain incarcerated senior citizens (over the age of 60) who have served 20 years or more of their prison sentence.

PREACHING	
Dedicate one Sunday service to discussing the harms of mass incarceration and the aging population of those in New Jersey prisons	
Identify the date of the service	
Announce the service regularly in morning announcements	
Create a flyer for the church bulletin, website, and social media	
Consider creating a countdown clock for social media	
Invite advocates, lawmakers, and local media to the Sunday service	
Consider developing your sermon using the following theological resources prepared by Rev. J. Amos Caley of Reformed Church of Highland Park	
TEACHING	
After your Sunday service, host a conversation about NJ seniors in prison with the congregation, local community, advocates, and lawmakers	
Consider a panel discussion about releasing seniors from prison and how that could impact the Black community	

Consider a roundtable discussion about how the community has been impacted by mass incarceration and document the stories told	
Research statistics on the harms of mass incarceration in the Black community by <u>visiting the Second Look NJ website</u>	
Set up informational tables before and after service with toolkits and additional resources on mass incarceration in the Black community and ways to advocate for more equitable policies statewide	
MOBILIZING	
Contact your State Representatives, using SandSJ's prepared call script, and urge them to advance Senate Bill 2338 which would provide rehabilitative release for seniors over the age of 60 who have been incarcerated for 20 years or more
